GAS TRUCKS

PROCEDURES

Operation	Operate to bring up to working temperatures and inspected.
Hydraulics	Check hydraulics under load to verify proper operation & no leaks or drifting.
Mast	Inspect mast including rollers and chains to verify in good condition.
Forks	Inspect to verify forks are in good condition and within spec - paint.
Engine	Verify no leaks, noise or smoke - change oil and filters - tune up / clean compartment.
Transmission	Confirm transmission is pulling properly.
Brakes	Inspect brakes for proper operation and no leaks, including hand brake.
Steer Axle	Confirm that steer axle operates properly.
Radiator	Inspect for clogging and leaks.
Cooling System	Inspect for clogging and leaks.
Tires	Tires should be at least 80% or greater with no damaged areas.
Cosmetics	Should be a good looking truck - excellent cosmetics, new floormat.
Seat	No torn or dirty seat - replace if necessary.
Paint	Excellent paint - close attention to details.
Accessories	Verify all accessories operate properly.
Safety Equipment	All safety equipment must be in good working order.
Final Check	Technician/Used Equipment Manager to make final check prior to shipment.

ELECTRIC TRUCKS

Same guidelines as gas trucks, plus:

Electrical	Examine motor and contactors for wear and condition.
Battery	Remove from truck and inspect - paint if necessary. 1 Year Warranty.
Charger	Verify charger operates properly.
